IAF also maintains a 8.1 hectare Learning Laboratory for Agroforestry (LLA). Showcasing different agroforestry systems and technologies, the LLA serves as the learning laboratory of agriculture, forestry and agroforestry classes at UPLB; research area of UPLB staff and graduate students; and, practicum area of training courses being organized by the Institute, other UPLB units, and organizations outside UPLB.
